Los **comparative adjectives** se utilizan para comparar una determinada característica o cualidad entre dos o más cosas, animales o personas.



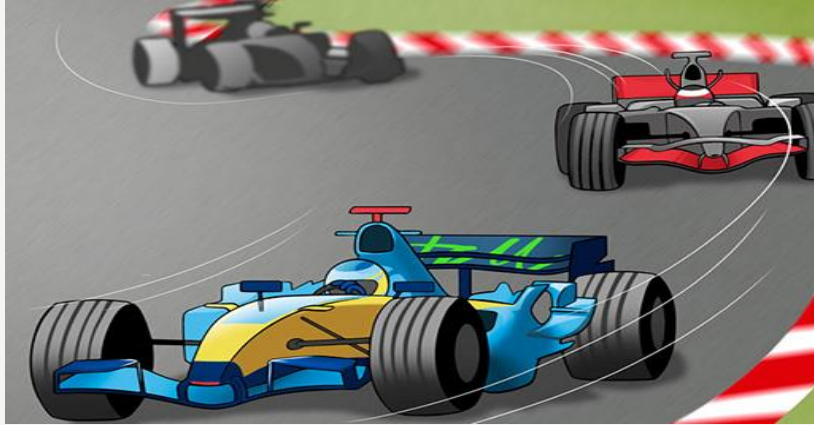
The mouse is smaller than the owl.

El ratón es *más pequeño* que el búho.



SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

Los **superlative adjectives** expresan el grado máximo de una característica de un elemento con respecto a otros de su mismo grupo o condición.



The fastest car is the blue one.
El coche **más rápido** es el azul.

	ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
One-syllable adjectives	CHEAP	CHEAP-ER	THE CHEAP-EST
Two-syllable adjectives	HEALTHY	HEALTH-I-ER	THE HEALTH-I-EST
Two-syllable adjectives not ending in "-y"	BORING	MORE BORING	THE MOST BORING
Three or more syllable adjectives	EXPENSIVE	MORE EXPENSIVE	THE MOST EXPENSIVE
